## **RESULTS**

The Water Temple Centennial Planning Group prepared and circulated a survey to gather input from the Community of Sunol regarding future restoration and development of the Water Temple grounds. The input is intended for the SFPUC to use as a basis for discussion of this project as they develop their plans for the Water temple. The community looks forward to this discussion and the improvement of the Water temple environment for educational and recreational uses.

Following is a summery of the data gathered. All respondents did not respond to all items and did not provide all of the information requested. One hundred and fifty three (153) community members returned surveys from the nearly 500 that were distributed. We hope that those who reviewed the Survey have thought about it and will to be involved in the discussion.

Community members may not have had enough information to provide informed responses, but we hope that their questions will be raised and discussed at future opportunities to do so. This discussion has just begun.
