## Notice of Wastewater Permit Issuance

Pursuant to San Francisco Public Works Code, Article 4.1, § 125(d), notice is hereby given that the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC)'s General Manager is issuing :

- **Wastewater Batch Discharge Permit No. 18-01207 to 4355 Mission St, The Jewish Home of San Francisco to discharge an estimated 700,000 gallons into the public sewer system at 4355 Mission Street. The Permit contains applicable sampling and reporting requirements and is set to expire on December 31, 2019.**

A copy of the permit is available upon request by contacting Tomio Takeshita at (415) 695-7310. The above permit shall become final 15 calendar days after the date of this posting, unless a public hearing request is filed (see below).

Public Hearing Request: Any person who deems that his or her interests or property or that the general public interest will be adversely affected by the issuance of the permit may request a public hearing within 15 calendar days of the date of this posting. (S.F. Public Works Code § 125(e).) If the aforementioned 15-day appeal deadline expires on a weekend or holiday, the filing date shall be the following business day. Upon receipt of a timely request for a public hearing, the General Manager of the SFPUC or his designee shall hold a public hearing after giving notice as required by San Francisco Public Works Code Article 4.1, § 129(b).
