The Maisin Scholar Award, Carollo Engineers and the Southeast Community Facility Commission are excited to announce **two scholarships for Bayview-Hunters Point students** in addition to the 75 scholarships Maisin offers: a \$3,000/year renewable scholarship for a Bayview-Hunters Point student interested in STEM careers, and a \$3,000/year renewable scholarship in honor of Dr. Espanola Jackson, a long-time civil rights and community advocate for Bayview-Hunters Point.

Why Should I Apply?

Maisin Scholars can receive up to \$3,000 a year for up to four years for their college education. Plus, you'll receive academic and career counseling as well as professional development opportunities.

Who Can Apply?

SFUSD high school seniors with a cumulative unweighted GPA between 2.0 and 3.5 who will attend college or a vocation program in Fall 2018. Low-income, historically under-represented, and first-generation college students are given higher consideration. Students who may not qualify for other scholarships because of their GPA or immigrant status are encouraged to apply.
