

30 Day Construction Notice: Sunset Boulevard Greenway Project

Description: The San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC) will begin Phase 2 of construction of new green infrastructure features to naturally capture stormwater along Sunset Boulevard. Rain garden design concepts reflect the natural topography and soil conditions of Sunset Boulevard, which are supportive of stormwater infiltration.

When: Work will begin November 2019 with completion anticipated November 2020. To minimize construction duration and impacts to the community, construction crews will be working weekdays from 7:00am – 4:00pm. Crews will coordinate with schools in the project area to avoid construction activities during drop-off and pick-up times.

Where: Southbound direction of Sunset Boulevard, between Irving and Ulloa streets. Crews will be working at 3-4 block sections at a time. Additional targeted notices will be sent in advance as the project site changes.

What to expect:

- There will be noise, vibration, dust, parking and traffic impacts in work zone.
- Residents near the work zone will maintain access to their homes.
- Parking will be prohibited in the work zone during work hours. Please see posted signs for exact details.
- A city construction inspector will be on-site during work hours and may be able to assist you with construction concerns. Inspectors typically wear a yellow safety vest and hard hat.
- A short interruption of water service when crews are making connections to new pipe. Advance notice will be given.
