

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Public Hearing to consider adoption of revisions to the Floodwater Management Grant Assistance Program regarding the disbursement of grant funds and program eligibility requirements.

At its regular meeting on September 22, 2020, 1:30 PM, to be held via teleconference, the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC) will consider the following modifications to the **Floodwater Management Grant Assistance Program** (Grant Program):

- 1. Provide up-front payment for contractor deposits to secure work for applicants who demonstrate financial hardship;*
- 2. Allow all payments up to the full grant amount to be installment payments instead of reimbursements for applicants who demonstrate financial hardship;*
- 3. Extend hardship benefits to businesses and non-profit organizations with a maximum of 50 full-time employees; and*
- 4. Remove eligibility criterion requiring proof of prior flooding for Grant Program eligibility. Instead, all properties likely to experience approximately 6 inches or more of flooding during a 100-year storm, per the SFPUC's hydrologic and hydraulic model, are eligible for grant funding.*
